When: Every 2nd & 4th Tuesdays of

Months: Sept, Oct, Nov, Jan, Feb, Mar, Apr, May

Times: 10am-11am—Classroom Instruction may include use of firearms simulator
11:30am-12:30pm—Range Time

Who: All are welcome! Beginner to Expert

Fees: \$25/person Daily Fee includes classroom &/or range times
\$25 handgun rental fee if needed—ok to bring your own, please don't go buy before your try
\$12/box of 50 rounds of 9-mm ammo—required if renting from AGC or bring your own for your own handgun

Instructors: \$75/hour—I am donating my time to the ladies, but if we need an additional instructor they will need to be paid and will be a shared additional cost for the day

Note: We are reserving two days of each month so we can offer our Texana's the flexibility of when they can practice with their firearms. You can attend both days, just one, or skip if needed.

Classroom: Basic fundamentals for handgun shooting such as safety rules, proper hold, stance, sight picture, nomenclature—all you need to know before you go out to the range. Practice on the simulator before going to the range to get a "feel" for target shooting. Once basics are covered, we will move to situational awareness and self defense with the use of the scenarios on the simulator.

Classroom time is geared towards new shooters to progress and become familiar with their handguns. If you feel comfortable with your handgun, join us on the range....

Each month will have a theme for us to cover such as handgun basics, ammunition, cleaning, personal protection, etc.

Range: Range time will take what was learned in the classroom and transfer it to live fire of our handguns. We are going to utilize the NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program Pistol Course of Fire to track our success on the range. This is a self-paced program designed to take you through different levels of skills from beginner to intermediate even up to nationally recognized level of Distinguished Expert on par with competition shooters. You will be able to mark your successes with the NRA Awards for each level with certificates, patches, and/or pins.
